Bicycle/pedestrian

Bicycles can be parked in corrals along Main Avenue during the summer and locked to bike racks on meter poles. Covered, lighted bicycle parking is located at the Transit Center.

Colorado state law requires motorists to yield to pedestrians in crosswalks.

Fines cost up to \$250 and will double if not paid within 30 days. Payment locations:

- City Hall (949 East 2nd Ave., 7:30a.m. - 3:30 p.m. M-F).
- Drive-thru drop-off at the Post Office (222 W. 8th St.)
- Library drop-off (1900 East Third Ave., south side by the book drop)

Bicicleta/peatón

Las bicicletas se pueden parquear en corrales a lo largo de main avenue durante el verano y se bloquean a portabicicletas en postes de medidores.
